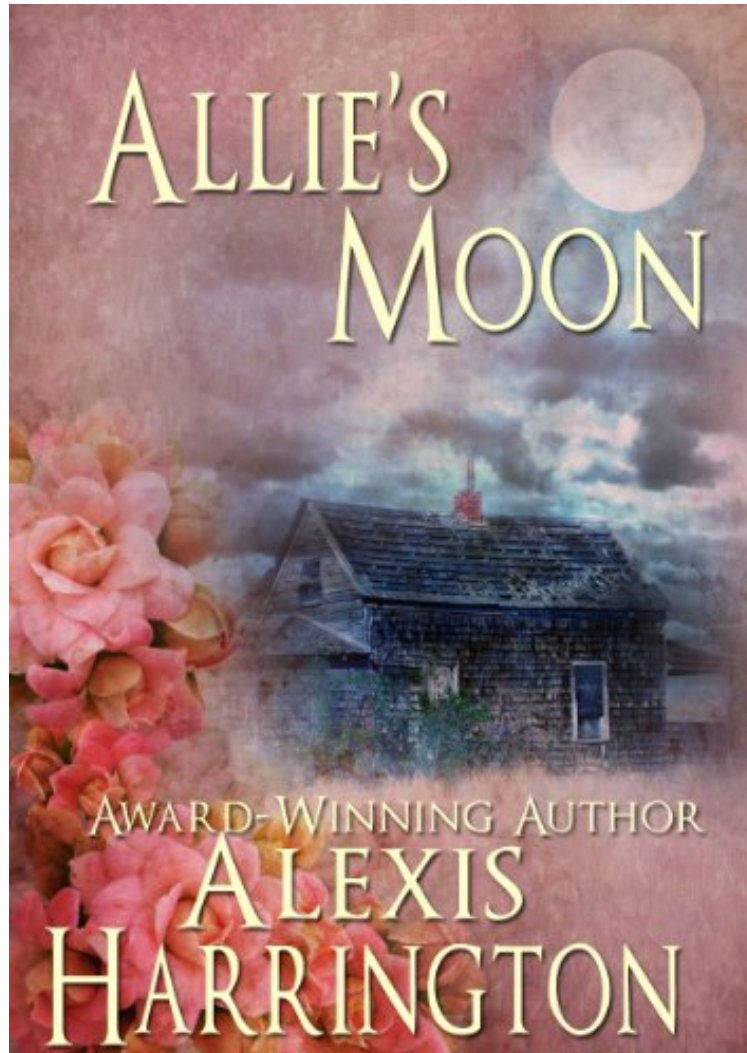

She dutifully fulfils her role and accepts that life has nothing warm and wonderful waiting for her.Jeff is a broken man, riddled with such guilt and remorse about shooting a young man in self-defence that he turns his back on life and retreats to the bottom of a bottle.The sheriff brings them together when Allie desperately needs help for basic maintenance on her property. Both are reluctant but see not alternative.The story is a wonderfully tender romance as Allie and Jeff

complement each other step by step. Allie finds the warmth and love that she never expected and she in turn brings out the best in him, allowing him to regain his sense of self-worth and purpose. Their relationship has a constancy and honesty that sees them through the malicious actions of others. The story is beautifully written. She detests coming to the town because everyone not so subtly keeps reminding her that her mama committed suicide and her beloved sister Olivia suffers from spells. However, it is only in town that she will find someone to help work her run down farm. Former Sheriff Jefferson Hicks drowns his sorrows in a whisky bottle to bury the guilt eating at his gut caused by a fatal shooting. He hits a new low when a local farmer catches him stealing eggs and presses charges. Instead of locking up Jefferson, Sheriff Will Mason assigns his old friend to work for four months on the Ford spread. As Will and Allie work closely together on the farm, they find salvation and fall in love. However, the frail Olivia, encouraged by their now deceased father, grew up totally dependent on her older sister. She cannot abide the developing relationship between her "guardian" and the former law enforcement official. Olivia does everything in her power to break the lovebirds apart. A murder occurring on the Ford property casts doubts on the innocence of Will and Allie and threatens to destroy their blossoming affair. Alexis Harrington is quickly earning a reputation for her relationship dramas that focus on love's ability to heal the most scarred souls. Her latest novel, ALLIE'S MOON is a deeply moving western romance with an exciting story line that is clearly character-driven. The lead protagonists are scarred from life's lessons until they find one another and teach each other how to heal. Olivia is an interesting but complex secondary player who challenges those around her. Liebesgeschichte mit Krimi-Elementen Von Bcherliebe Das Titelbild hatte mir so gut gefallen und mich neugierig gemacht, weil es geheimisvoll aussieht. Das Buch wurde in der dritten Person erzht. Es entwickelt sich auch nicht, wie die typischen Mail-Order-Bride Geschichten. Darin eingewoben ist noch ein Krimi, bei dem alte Feindschaften und Eifersucht eine Rolle spielen. Allie (heute 27 Jahre) lebt mit ihrer Schwester Olivia (20 Jahre) alleine auf einer heruntergekommenen Farm in Oregon. Ihre Schwester ist schwchlich und hat psychotische Anflle. Ihre Mutter beging Selbstmord, als Allie 7 Jahre alt war. Seit dem mute sie die Mutterrolle einnehmen und den Haushalt fhren. Vor drei Jahren starb auch noch der Vater. Nun suchen sie hnderingend Arbeiter, um die Farm instand zu setzen. Aber niemand will mit den "verrckten Schwestern" des Ortes etwas zu tun haben. Der heruntergekommene Jeff, ein ehemaliger Sheriff, verbringt die meiste Zeit betrunken in der Kneipe. Als er beim Eier stehlen erwischt wird, verdonnert ihn der Sheriff zur Arbeit auf der Farm von den Schwestern. Jeff bringt das leckende Dach in Ordnung, pflgt die Felder, sat die Saaten und erledigt seine Arbeiten ordentlich. Er findet wieder Gefallen an rechtsschaffender Arbeit. Dabei nchert er aus und schpft auch neuen Lebensmut. Auch bilden sich zarte Bande zu Allie. Derweilen nehmen Olivias psychotische Anflle zu. Das Buch beginnt langsam und etwas zh. Erst ab der Hlfte entwickelt sich immer mehr eine Liebesbeziehung. Dank der Krimi-Elemente zum Ende hin wird die Handlung noch viel spannender. Mir hat das Buch Spa gemacht. Aber die ganz groen Emotionen, lieen doch sehr lange auf sich warten. Stellenweise waren mir die inneren Monologe und Tagtrume der Protagonisten etwas lang geraten, so dass ich manche Zeilen nur berflogen habe.
