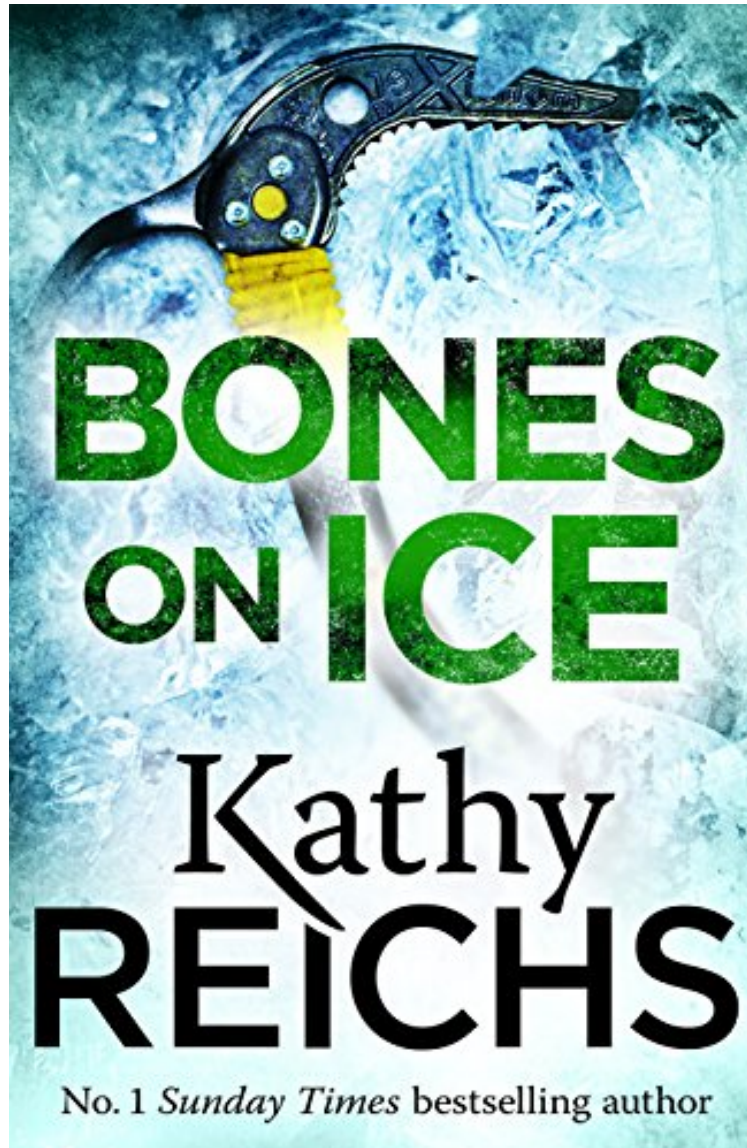

The post mortem, too, is very illuminating for all those readers interested in all the details, from teeth to toes there is literally EVERYTHING examined. The reader will learn about "paradoxical undressing", while the body is freezing to death, an abnormal behavior only present in 20 - 50 % of the cases. And "terminal burrowing", another strangeness often found with people frozen to death. First difficulty found, better NOT found, there are no teeth to compare - very strange. The skin texture is about that of Oetzi, whose story is remembered here as the ICEMAN - the best preserved ice-mummy ever found. Fingerprints are almost out of question on this type of corpse, so Tempe is forced to contact next of kin, the mother. And what a mother - panty hose in her house, spreading venom on her late husband, having passed on his "poison" in his blood onto his children. Very nice encounter, really...But of nice encounters there will be more, with the other members of the climbing crew. Who were all finally to make the "Seventh Summit" - but were all so-called "virgins" in the 5-Mile-Zone. And everything becomes always more intricate - jealousy, money, a new Seven-Summiter and all the glory that comes with it. And all the 4 survivors are telling different tales or lies or what they dreamt in those low-oxygen heights under the Mother of all Mountains.
