Strahd is not some stupid archetypal vampire (re: his portrayal in Knight of the Black Rose). Despite the slow start, the novel picked up as emotions raged in Strahd. Elrod's linguistics are very developed: fluid, rich and demanding. I haven't read many Ravenloft novels (four), but this and its sequel are probably the best you'll find. But I can't agree with the five stars flying all around about this book.
